

Dear members and friends of Trinity, Auburn,

These are unprecedented times concerning the Coronavirus, COVID-19. 48 hours ago I wrote a letter that Trinity was going to remain open for worship services, fellowship meals, and Bible studies for the time being. With the recommendation today by officials for people to isolate themselves and avoid gatherings of more than 10 people, operating in a nearly normal fashion is not what we should be doing to do our part in helping to contain the spread of the virus.

Effective immediately, we are suspending all activities at Trinity, including worship and GROW in the Son childcare, until which time we feel it appropriate to restart these activities. I, along with church leaders, will continue to evaluate the appropriate time to join together again. Ministry will continue during this time, it will just be done in a different way via Facebook, online video recordings accessible through Trinity's Youtube channel, and personal phone calls.
